



LETTER OF INTENT (LOI)


On this Tuesday the first of May 2012, The Association of Private Higher Education Institutions in Indonesia (APTISI) which represent 3150 Private Universities, Institutes, Academies, and Polytechnics in Indonesia, and accessUTS Pty Ltd (a subsidiary of the University of Technology, Sydney) hereby declare our intent to market and develop opportunities of co-operation between APTISI and accessUTS for the implementation of pan-Indonesian training programs for capacity building for academics and other tertiary sector staff. The focus areas for training will be in: *Academic Culture; Management and Governance of Universities, Colleges, Polytechnics and Schools; Enhancing Learning and Teaching; Establishing a Research Culture; Academic writing in English; Developing Quality Processes in Tertiary Organizations; Commercial Activities in Tertiary Organizations; and Short Term Study Tours for Academics to Australia.*


Both parties agree to work collaboratively to provide short course training experiences and study tour programs, facilitated by accessUTS and the University of Technology, Sydney for Indonesian tertiary sector staff and academics.

This letter of intent shall be succeeded by a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which shall authorize APTISI to act on behalf of accessUTS to promote short courses and study tours through its national Institution and membership network. APTISI will establish co-operative, on-going relationships with its Institution membership base for the pre-commencement requirements for some aspects of courses and study tours arrangements.


The spirit to encourage the bilateral cooperation between the Republic of Indonesia and Australia through the upcoming Indonesia Australia Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement (IA CEPA) is one the motivating factors of APTISI and accessUTS in establishing this cooperation. An MOU between APTISI and accessUTS elaborating more detailed activities of this cooperation shall be signed within 60 days upon signing of this LOI at the UTS campus Sydney.
